Today's Learning Spaces

Objective

- To use the knowledge and understanding from previous activities to explore ideas for today's learning spaces.
- To explain ways in which schools and classrooms now may be different to schools and classrooms in the past.
- Consider the best location for their school in relation to the locality as a whole.
- Be aware of what they themselves, as learners, would like to include in today's learning spaces.

Outcome

- A personal or group list of needs or desires for today's learners. (Mind map, List, Design/ Concept board)
- A plan or design of an ideal school or learning community.

Extension task

Some pupils may decide to make a 3D representation of their ideal school.

- Others may like to use Computer Aided Design Software to design their school.
- Designs may be scanned into Power Point or Photo Story software for presenting purposes.

- Ideas and presentations can be displayed in school or local libraries.

Activity

Pupils should reflect on previous sessions, knowledge and understanding, then brainstorm in small groups about which spaces they think are important and why?
